

Privacy Policy Statement

Statement of Policy

“Construction Industry Caring Campaign – Fight against Novel Coronavirus” Management Committee (the "Organiser", "we" or "us") pledges to comply with the requirements of the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance (Cap.486) of the Laws of Hong Kong. In doing so, we will ensure compliance by our staff with the strictest standards of security and confidentiality. When we collect personal data from individuals, we will provide them with a Personal Information Collection Statement ("PICS") on or before the collection in an appropriate format and manner.

Statement of Practice

Your personal information collected and held by us will only be used for all purposes relating to the Lucky Draw. Information collected during the Lucky Draw campaign may be disclosed and transferred to the data processor or other agents of the Organiser who are engaged in relation to the conducting or monitoring of the Lucky Draw for such purpose only and on a need-to-know basis, without the relevant participant's prior consent. Such information will be properly stored and encrypted, and will be destroyed within 90 days after the campaign ends.

Use of cookies

When you visit this Site, we may automatically track and collect your IP address, domain server, the type of computer and type of web browser you are using and use "cookies" to improve and update this Site as well as to maintain, manage and enhance user experience. We may share the information collected by us with third party research agencies for research and analysis to enable us to enhance services and user experience. No personally identifiable information about you will be shared with these third party research agencies.

Most browsers are initially set up to accept cookies. You can choose not to accept cookies by changing the setting of your computer or mobile, but

you may find that certain features on this Site may not work properly.

Personal Data Security

We will take practicable measures to safeguard data security including protection against unauthorised or accidental access, processing, erasure, loss or use. Despite our effort to protect your personal data, given the nature of the internet, we cannot guarantee perfect security of data transmission over it. However, once we receive your transmission, we use our best endeavours to ensure its security in our own systems. Your personal data will only be accessed by our authorized personnel.

Disclosure of Personal Data

The personal data collected by us will not be disclosed, provided or transferred to any other party in a form that would identify you except to the parties as set out in the Personal Information Collection Statement provided to you on or before the collection of your personal data. Your personal data collected by us will not be sold to any parties.

In cases when we have reason to believe that disclosing your personal data is necessary to identify, contact or bring legal action to protect or defend our rights or against someone who may be violating the terms or may be causing injury to or interference with our rights or property, other users, or anyone else that could be harmed by such activities, we may disclose your personal data. We may also disclose to the related parties or organisations or access your personal data when we believe in good faith that the law requires it.
